Thanks for reaching out!

Self hosted WordPress blogs can sometimes be tricky to work well with IFTTT. It's unfortunate because there isn't much that we can do from our side of things to help connect your WP to IFTTT because custom settings come in all shapes and sizes. Make sure the username you have activated <https://ifttt.com/channels/wordpress/reactivate> has full Admin rights and that the Blog URL is correct. Update your WP blog to the latest version. You may also want to look into how your Feed is created from your WP as well, make sure that it is working directly. Does WordPress see any alternative URLs for your blog?

If all fails to work, you can still trigger from your blog by using its RSS Feed with the IFTTT Feed Channel <http://ifttt.com/feed> Or even use our Gmail Channel <http://ifttt.com/gmail> to auto post to your blog, see here for inspiration:
